PAYING YOUR FEES AND LIVING EXPENSES



Not accessed a Tuition Fee Loan before? Then applying for finance should be a doddle. You can get funding to cover the cost of your tuition for each year of your course. Apply for it all at once if you know you're committed to study for a full three years or apply a year at a time.

Need help with living costs too? There's a maintenance loan available too worth up to £10,544. What you'll get will depend on your personal circumstances but the calculator mentioned bottom left should give you a good idea once the figures for 2025-26 are finalised.



With nothing to pay upfront and repayments that don't kick in until you've finished your course and reached a certain annual salary (last year this was £25,000), the money side of things could be a whole lot easier than you might imagine.

Student loans don't affect your credit rating either or impact on your ability to borrow funds for other purposes like buying a house, so it isn't the same as taking on other kinds of debt. It's more about investing in your future and in your family's future too – a bit like buying shares in yourself to maximise your potential.



Worried about how much repayments will be once you reach the threshold? Let's put that into context for you as well. Based on last year's figures (and we can't imagine they will differ vastly this year), the table opposite shows you different salary levels and how much your repayments would have been on a monthly basis.

NON-REPAYABLE GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL SUPPORT

There's a variety of additional non-repayable financial support available from the Government. Here is a list of what was on offer last year to give you some idea of what you might be eligible for.

Help for those supporting an adult partner or relative
Adult Dependants' Grant worth up to £3,438 in 2024/5.

Help for parents
Parents' Learning Allowance worth between £50 and £1,963 a year in 2024/5 if you were a full-time student with children.

Childcare Grant
Last year you were able to claim up to £193.62 a week for one child or up to £331.95 a week for two or more children if you were a full-time student and had a child or children under 15 or under 17 if they had special educational needs.

Help if you have a learning difficulty, health problem or disability.
A Disabled Students' Allowance which last year was worth up to £26,948 can be used to help cover the study-related costs you might have due to a mental health problem, long-term illness or disability.

NON-REPAYABLE B&FC FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Please note: the Scholarships and Bursaries described below are subject to the approval of our Access and Participation Plan 2025/26-2028/29 by the Office for Students.

B&FC's Career and Skills Development Fund 2025/26 (worth £250)
What: Means-tested non-repayable bursary up to £250. Household income must be less than £30,810. **For:** Career-development opportunities.

B&FC's HE Equipment Fund 2025/26 (worth £300)
What: Means-tested non-repayable bursary up to £300. Household income must be less than £30,810. **For:** Initial equipment set up in your first term of study e.g. PC/laptop, books, software.

B&FC's HE Equipment Plus Fund 2025/26 (worth £200)
What: Means-tested non-repayable bursary up to £200. Household income must be less than £30,810. **For:** Ongoing equipment costs in second and third year of study e.g. stationery, books, internet at home.

B&FC Cares Scholarship 2025/26 (worth up to £3000 over 3 years)

What: Non-repayable scholarship of up to £1000 per year. **For:** Students who are care leavers, carers or estranged from their family network.

B&FC's DSA Student Contribution Award 2025/26 (worth £200)

What: One-off, non-repayable contribution of £200 to cover the cost of your contribution to DSA. **For:** Students in receipt of DSA

Educational Psychology Assessment Fund 2025/26 (worth £300+)

What: One-off payment to cover the cost of a Education Psychologist (EP) Assessment. **For:** Students for whom an EP Report is essential to support learning.

B&FC's HE Support Fund 2025/26

What: Discretionary financial support determined on a case by case basis. **For:** Students experiencing financial difficulty who are unable to meet basic or unexpected additional costs from other sources of support.

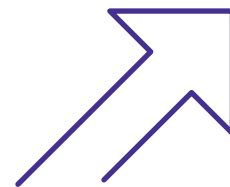

WHY IT PAYS

You may be eligible to do an Access to HE course for free! If not, you could get an Advanced Learner Loan to cover your course fees with nothing to pay upfront and no repayments until you reach the earnings threshold which last year was £25,000 a year. What's more, the loan is written off if you then go on to complete a degree-level qualification.

PREPARING YOU TO GO HIGHER

As well as learning subject specific modules, an Access course will build your academic skills and boost your confidence to get you ready for degree-level study. You'll learn academic skills such as planning, researching and referencing, all of which will make the transition onto a full-time degree qualification so much easier.

If your heart is set on going to university but you don't have the qualifications or experience, an Access to Higher Education Diploma gets you degree-ready in just one year. Studying at B&FC with access to experienced, specialist tutors and state-of-the-art facilities means you will be exceptionally well-placed to develop the skills and experience you need to progress on the path to your dream career.

The abbreviations seem to go on and on.

It's not surprising then that people find getting to grips with all the different degree-level qualifications these days a bit overwhelming at first. But honestly, it's more straightforward than you think.

Like most people, you probably think of degrees as a three year commitment. We do those here, but we also do a range of qualifications from Level 4 to Level 6 which allow you to ease yourself in gently to higher level study without committing to a full three years upfront. The table opposite breaks down the qualifications, the length of time each takes and how one qualification leads to another. All it means is that you have more flexibility to choose what you want to study and for how long. And, as far as we're concerned, that's a good thing.

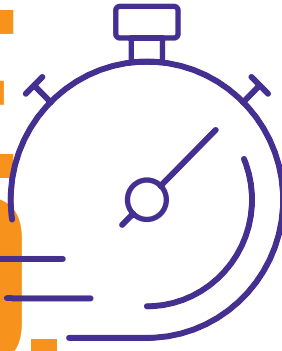
INTRODUCING HIGHER TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS

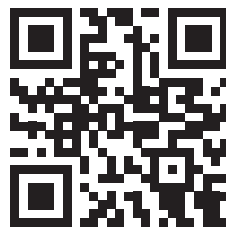

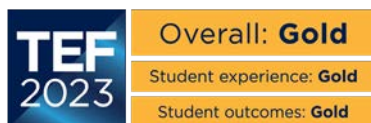
