

This guide describes the process of installing Citrix remote desktop services that allows staff and students to run a virtual College PC on an Android device (tablet or phone).

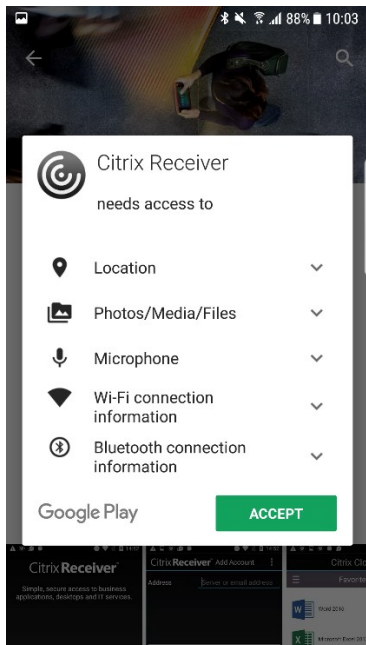
It is important to follow the guide in its entirety, clicking the options described and not skipping any steps.

Installation

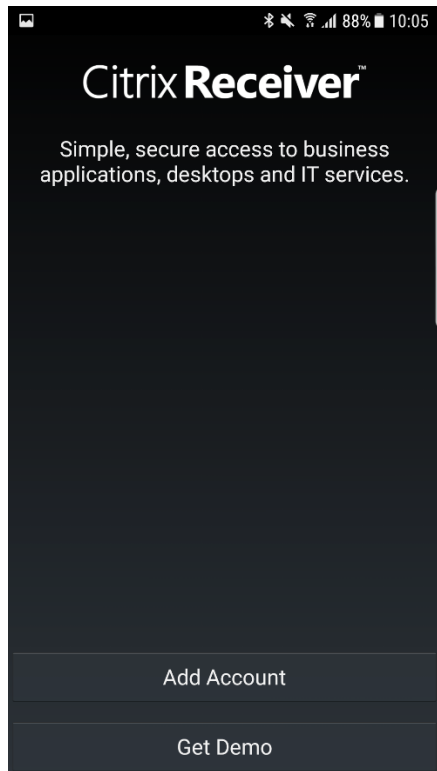
Step 1: Open the Google Play store on your iPhone / iPad and search for “Citrix Receiver”



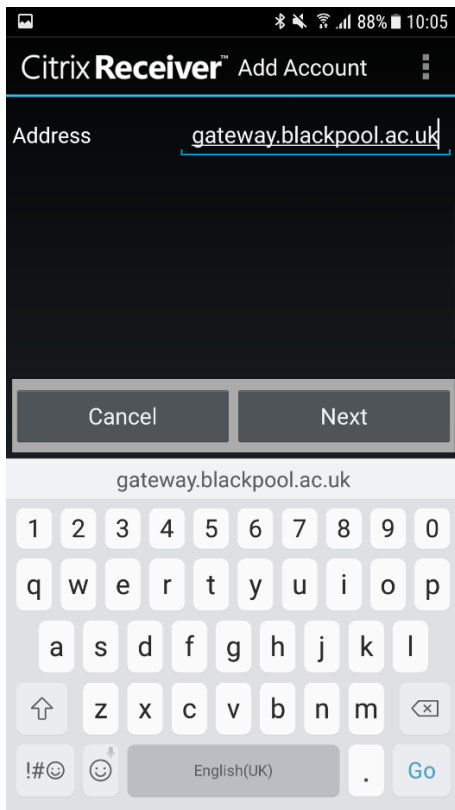
Step 2: Install the app, and accept the access requirements



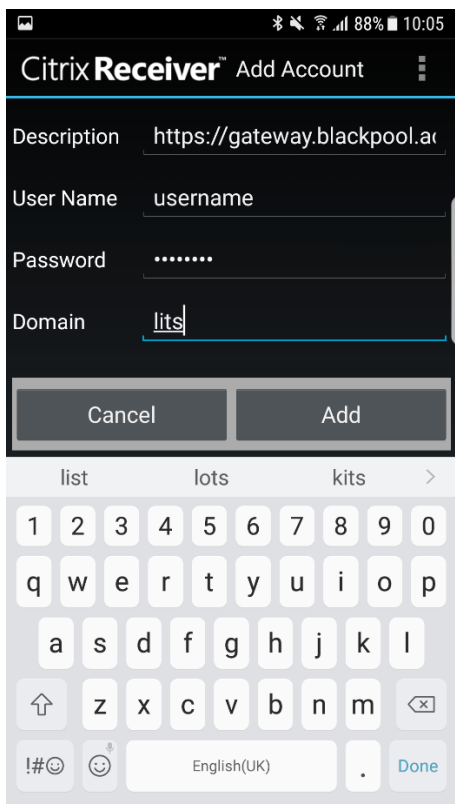
Step 3: Click Add Account



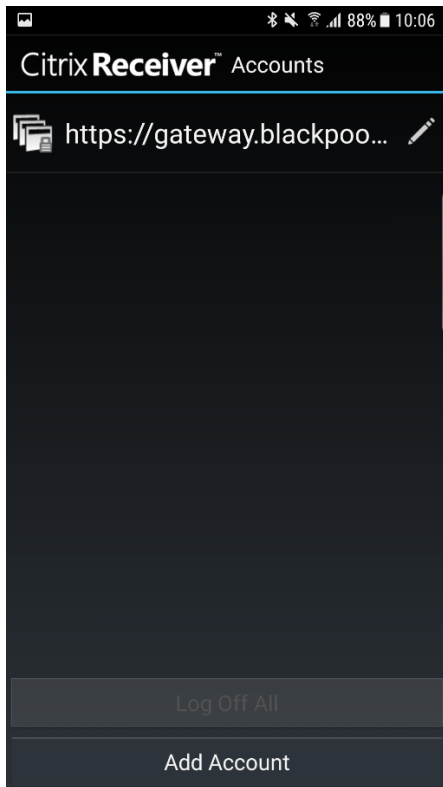
Step 4: Type in the Address "gateway.blackpool.ac.uk" then click Next



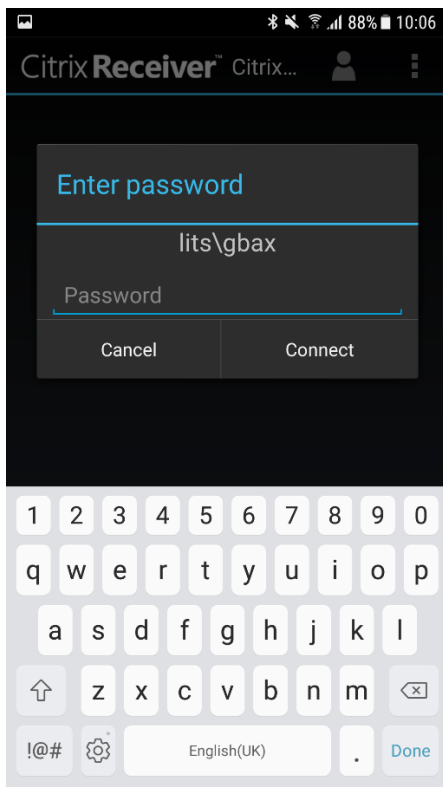
Step 5: Fill in your College login username, password and in the Domain box type "lits"



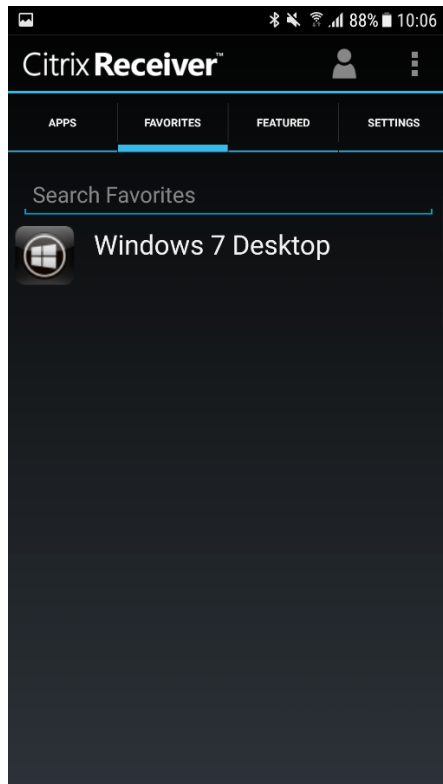
Step 6: Click on the link on the screen (https://gateway.blackpool...)



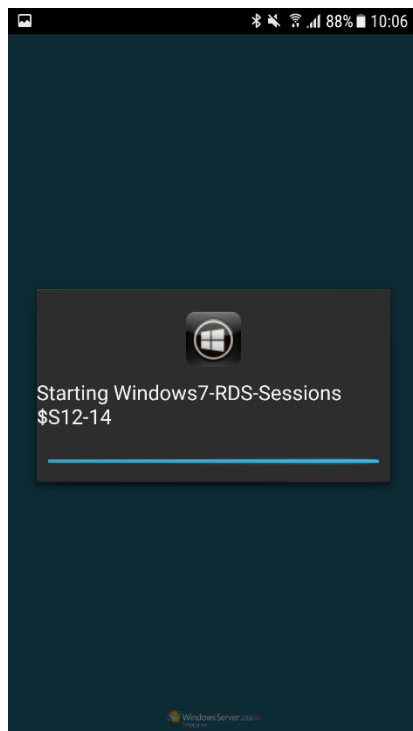
Step 7: Enter your College login password



Step 8: Click on the Windows 7 Desktop link



Step 9: The following screen should show as the virtual desktop is loading



Step 10: The virtual College desktop environment is now ready to use



Step 11: Once you have finished click on the Windows icon at the top left of the screen and click the “Disconnect” button



Step 12: Click “Yes” to confirm you want to disconnect
